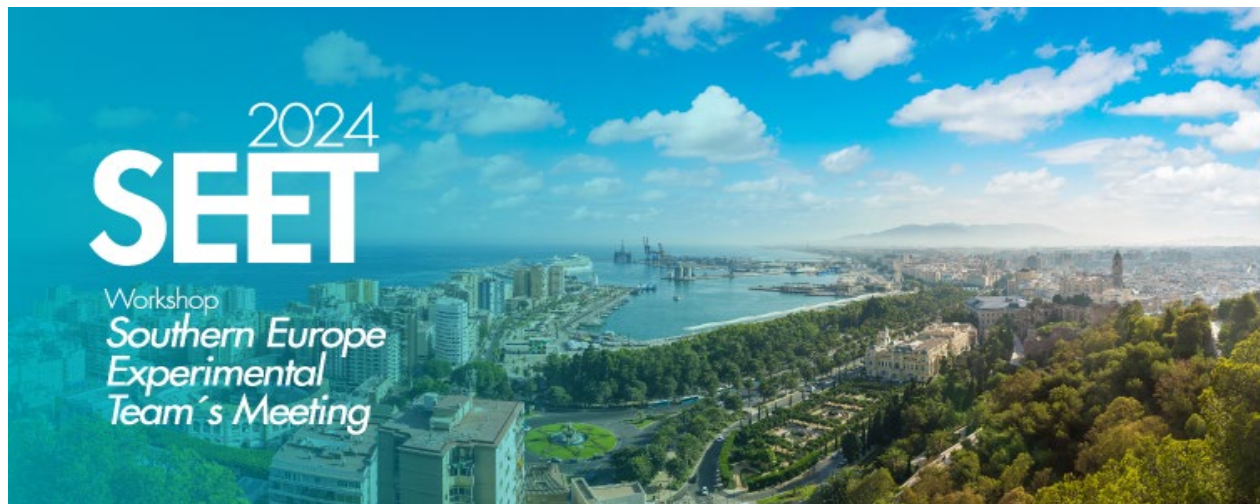




WALKING TOUR OF MALAGA

We will take a walking tour of the historic center of Malaga, reviewing the highlights of this city that has become a tourist and cultural reference in recent years.

We will begin next to the stature of the Marquis of Larios, at the entrance to the street that bears his same name and which will allow us to learn about the economic importance that this city achieved in the second half of the 19th century. We will continue towards the Plaza de la Constitución, the authentic heart of the city and a meeting place for all types of cultural and leisure activities throughout the year. We will continue through the streets of the center to reach the Plaza del Obispo and be amazed by the façade of the Cathedral; Our Lady of the Incarnation, one of the most outstanding monuments of the Spanish Renaissance that let astonished all visitors.

We will continue along San Agustín street to visit the exterior of the Picasso Museum, one of the renowned figures of Malaga who was born in our city in 1881 and whose collection attracts more than 700,000 visitors a year; all of Málaga is impregnated with Picasso and his genius. We will continue to the Plaza de la Merced to visit the exterior of Picasso's birthplace, the current Museum where there are family and personal objects of the painter to continue to the exterior of the Alcazaba, a key monument in the defense of the city in the period of the Malaga of Al-Andalus.

From there we will go to the Customs Museum (La Aduana) to visit the plant dedicated to Archeology and which will help us take a tour of the past and present of the city that faces the future basing its activity on Culture, Tourism and New Technologies but showing its enormous past.
